

APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION OF A BLENDED SEED LOT IN SCOTLAND

Seed from lots previously certified or submitted for certification, and passed crops (or part crops) not previously submitted for seed certification are eligible for blending. If the crops or seed lots to this blend can only attain the status of the constituent with the lowest category/level. This form should only be used if at least one constituent is from seed previously certified or submitted for certification. (For bulking of crops or part crops only, Form **SDC 4A** should be used.) A separate Form **SDG 8** should be completed in **DUPLICATE** for each blended seed lot and sent to the Certifying Authority. At the same time the Request for Sampling and Testing (Form **SDG 5**) must be sent to the appropriate sampler.

- 1 APPLICANT'S NAME AND ADDRESS.** This must be completed in full. Both copies of the completed SDG 8 must be sent to:

- 2 SEED LOT REFERENCE NUMBER.** Enter the Seed lot Reference. number of the blended lot. For cereals this will be constructed using the lowest crop identity listed (whether or not is part of a Seed Lot Reference Number). If this crop identity number has been previously used in the construction of Seed Lot Reference No's. care should be taken that the next number in the sequence is allocated to this blend and not lot/01.
- 3 CATEGORY.** Enter the category ie Pre-Basic, Basic, C (Certified Seed), C1 (Certified Seed of the 1st Generation), C2 (Certified Seed of the 2nd Generation).
- 4 KIND.** Enter the kind e.g. Wheat, Barley, Field Beans, Timothy etc.
- 5 LEVELS.** This box should be completed for Wheat, Barley, or Oats of categories other than Pre-Basic or for Certified Grasses and Herbage Legume. Enter "**H**" (Higher Voluntary Standard) or "**L**" (Minimum Statutory Standards).
- 6 ORIGINAL SEED LOT REFERENCE NUMBER.** If this seed lot has been downgraded or where a new Seed Lot Reference Number has been allocated, the original Reference Number of the seed lot should be entered. If this application is a re-sampled seed lot enter the word "**RETEST**" and give the previous Sample Report Number.
- 7** Give details of the Testing Station in the space provided. Also give the Testing Station Number in the box provided. Use Prefix S for Scottish Seed Testing Station e.g. SO1 and Prefix E for a Seed Testing Station in England and Wales. For OSTs, Scotland the number to be entered is SO9.
- 8 CONSTITUENTS OF BLEND.** Enter Crop Identity Number(s) and or Seed Lot Reference Number(s) (even for failed seed lots) and give details as appropriate.
